


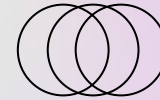
Mission

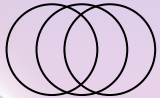

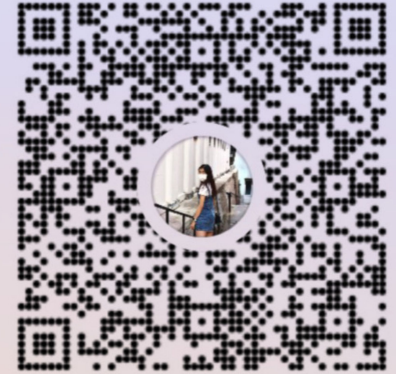

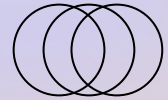


Icebreaker!

GBM Model



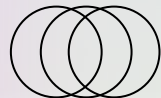
