

# Dr. Jason Emory, Lecturer at UC Merced The Role of Implicit Cognition and Stress in Health Disparities

#### **Event Details**

Dr. Jason Emory is a full-time lecturer in Psychological Sciences at University of California, Merced. His research and teaching interests focus upon the impact of implicit, unconscious cognition upon social perception and health related issues. This talk will focus upon implicit automatic brain/nervous-system processes and their role in social biases such as ingroup preference and outgroup prejudice. By understanding the basic process of how stereotypes are represented in the brain, we can better understand how these stereotypes are developed in the first place. These biases can lead not only obviously prejudiced ideas, but also to subtle unconscious biases of which an individual might not be aware. The talk will conclude with adiscussion of how these unconscious biases (i.e. stereotypes) can help to explain racial health disparities in the United States.
