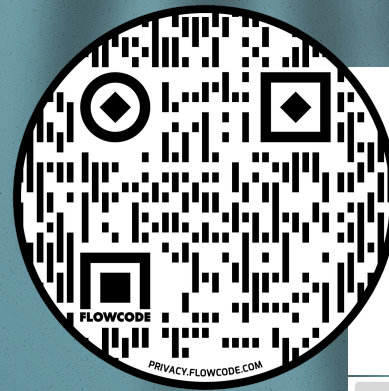

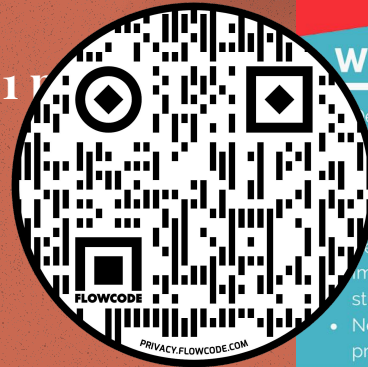

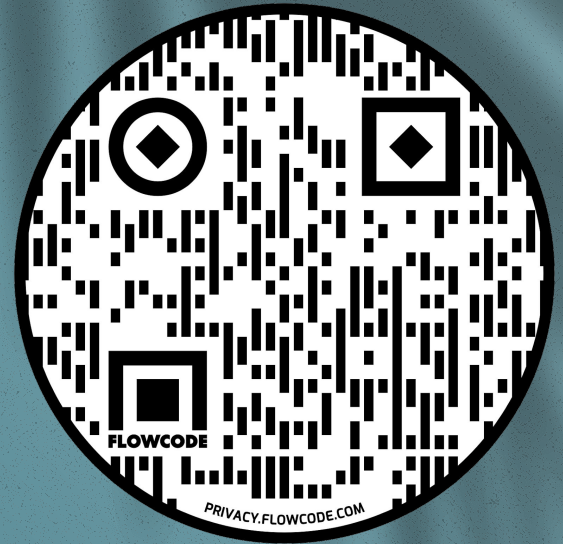

Attention users of E-Cigarettes, Juul, or vapes!

You may be eligible to participate in a research study of e-cigarettes that is being conducted by San Diego State University to understand e-cigarette usage and other factors.

EXAMINING REAL-TIME
EFFECTS OF
E-CIGARETTE
INHALATION AND EXPOSURE



Eligible participants will earn up to \$100 over the course of this nine-week study through participation in all research activities.

This study involves vaping your normal device and providing data over 3 months, including attendance at study visits, wearing a silicone wristband, collection of study vape pods, and having a non-vaping roommate (or equivalent) who is willing to participate.

You may be eligible to participate in this research study if you:

- Are you at least 21 years old
- Have been using e-cigarettes for at least 6 months
- Have a roommate or living partner that does not vape who would also like to enter the study
- Are fluent in English
- And have no major health issues
