Institute for Behavioral and Community Health Intern Position – Course Credit Available

The SDSU Institute for Behavioral and Community Health (IBACH; https://www.ibachsd.org/) is seeking a graduate student intern to support the Motivate Me pilot project, including planning, pre-testing, and conducting a randomized controlled trial. Dr. Tracy Finlayson (SDSU Professor of Public Health) co-leads the project with Dr. Scott Kelley (SDSU Professor of Biology).

The first phase of the project is to develop and test The project will develop and test a brief motivational interviewing intervention for oral health with 14-19 year old Latino adolescents in San Diego county. Motivational Interviewing (M) intervention material will be developed with inputs from adolescents (N=10) and tested in a randomized controlled trial (N=30-50) with Latino adolescents. We seek to assess the efficacy of a motivational interviewing intervention program to usual oral health care. This position will support the data collection, analysis, and report-writing efforts for the trial. The interm may also support other project efforts, including preparing presentations and other needed research support.

Position Details:

- 5-10/hours per week, flexible schedule possible
- This position will be remote for Fall 2020. At least one semester commitment required.
- This position is not paid, but SDSU field placement course credit is available

Duties and Responsibilities:

- · Collaborate with project personnel in participant recruitment efforts
- · Work with the research team members to develop and execute the MI intervention
- Assist in conducting baseline and endline assessments
- Conduct interviews and document gathered feedback for planning and process evaluation
- · Assist with scheduling interviews and preparing interview materials
- Assist with data entry and management
- Analyze data and write summaries
- Prepare presentations of results
- Prepare correspondence, including meeting agendas, minutes, and records of project activities and related data

Minimum Knowledge & Abilities:

- Current student or recent graduate (BS), with preference given to public health graduate students
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Good organizational skills
- Experience using Microsoft Office and ZOOM

Preferred Qualifications:

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- Background knowledge of community-engaged research
- Experience with conducting individual interviews and qualitative data analysis
- Some prior research experience
- · Familiarity with oral health concepts
- · Bilingual in English and Spanish (helpful, but not required)
